1.0 PURPOSE

It is the policy of the Public Schools Branch to declare, establish and maintain a tobacco and smoke free environment on all Public Schools Branch property.

3.0 PARAMETERS

3.1 The Public Schools Branch acknowledges that health-related problems can arise from the use of tobacco products and exposure to smoking and wishes to help protect and promote the health of all students, staff, volunteers and visitors by creating tobacco and smoke free schools, workplaces, vehicles and properties.
